Request Library Card

The library welcomes scholars with a minimum of a master's degree in one of the subjects it is specialized in such as archaeology, classical philology, ancient history, and related fields. Access is also granted to individuals holding a bachelor's degree in these subjects accompanied by additional university studies or professional involvement in the field of classical studies.

Documents required for registration

For those who frequented the library before it relocated to Via Sardegna 79, it is sufficient to present the old library card. Reader cards from other libraries of the German Archaeological Institute are accepted.

Prospective applicants are kindly asked to provide either an original or a copy of a document validating their access authorization, such as a graduation certificate, matriculation document, university lecturer's card, or an employee card from a museum or monument office. Additionally, the submission of a passport-sized photo is necessary for the issuance of the library card.

The first issue of a library card is free of charge. A processing fee of €10 is charged when a replacement card is issued.
